Procedure Words

Over: end of my transmission. I will listen for & expect your reply

Out: end of my transmission. No reply is expected.

Roger, Romeo or Copied: I have received your message and it is understood

Say again: please repeat

Correction: I have made a mistake; this following version is correct.

Wait or standby: I will call you back soon.

Affirmative or : yes, right
Negative : No, wrong

I spell: I will spell the word or name using phonetic alphabet

Radio check: request to confirm that your radio is operating correctly, including an indication of the strength and clarity.

Make a Routine VHF Radio call (case 0116)

• Name and radio call sign of the other station (up to 3 times)

• "This is"

• The name and radio call sign of your boat (up to 3 times)

• "over"

select CH 16:

• "Tuffy ZMP 4646, (up to 3 times), this is Fisherman ZMS 2345 (up to 3 times), over"

• "Fisherman this is Tuffy, go CH 6, over"

• "Tuffy, this is Fisherman. Roger, switching CH 6. I'll call you, over"

select CH 6:

• "Tuffy, this is Fisherman, over"

• "Fisherman this is Tuffy, go ahead over"

Case TR

• "Conquest Radio (up to 3 times), this is Tuffy ZMP 4646 (up to 3 times) to do a TR, over"

• "select CH 16, Conquest Radio - go ahead"

• "Conquest Radio, this is Tuffy ZMP 4646, we have arrived at Gulf Harbour. Need you to do our TR, over"

• "Thanks Tuffy, I have all that and my radio out"

- "Coastguard Radio (up to 3 times), this is seabird ZMQ 8088 (up to 3 times) for a TR. over"

- "Coastguard radio this is seabird, departing from Westhaven Marina, destination Gulf Harbour via some fishing at Tiritiri. ETA Gulf Harbour 1800 this evening, 4 POB. over"
